ALAM - words to do with 'experience'

* Tidak hanya anak kecil yang **mengalami** mimpi buruk.

It's not only small children who **experience** nightmares.

* Mimpi buruk tidak hanya dialami oleh anak kecil.

Nightmares are not only experienced by small children.

* Perjalanan itu adalah **pengalaman** yang luar biasa.

That trip was an extraordinary experience.

*Mereka mencari pekerja yang berpengalaman.

They are looking for **experienced** workers.

Notes

- * mengalami (v): to experience (something); to go through (sth.)
- * pengalaman (n): an experience, experience
- * berpengalaman (v): to be experienced, to have experience

[The 'ber-' on 'berpengalaman' means: to have, so 'ber-pengalaman' = literally, 'having experience']
