

CURI – words to do with ‘steal’

* Ari **mencuri** uang itu.

*Ari **stole** that money.*

* Uang itu **dicuri** oleh Ari.

*That money **was stolen** by Ari.*

* Ini **pencurian** uang kripto terbesar yang pernah terjadi.

*This was the largest **theft** of crypto currency that ever happened.*

* He was accused as a cattle **thief** by the villagers.

Dia dituduh sebagai **pencuri** sapi oleh warga desa.

Notes

* **mencuri** (v): to steal (something)

* **pencurian** (n): theft, the stealing of (something).

* **pencuri** (n): a thief. [A ‘pencuri’ does the action of ‘mencuri’.]

Practice. Say it in Indonesian. For each word in bold use a CURI word. (Be ready to choose between *mencuri* and *dicuri* as needed.)

1. They tried to **steal** a Rembrandt painting.

Mereka berusaha **mencuri** lukisan Rembrandt.

2. Those teenagers committed **thefts** from three Alfamart shops. [with ‘melakukan’]

Anak-anak remaja itu melakukan **pencurian** dari tiga toko Alfamart.

3. What should you do if your passport **is stolen**?

Apa yang sebaiknya Anda lakukan jika paspor Anda **dicuri**?

4. **Thieves** of electronic goods are operating in schools in that area. [with ‘wilayah’]

Pencuri barang elektronik (sedang) beroperasi di sekolah-sekolah di wilayah itu.

5. The word *cur-an-mor* means “motor vehicle **theft**”. [with ‘bermotor’]

Kata ‘curanmor’ itu berarti “**pencurian** kendaraan bermotor”.

6. Three **thieves** of forest timber were arrested. [with ‘kayu’]

Tiga **pencuri** kayu hutan ditangkap.

7. That company **stole** trade secrets. [with ‘dagang’]

Perusahaan itu **mencuri** rahasia dagang.

8. Dozens of fish-poaching vessels (i.e., “ships, **thieves** of fish”) were caught.

Puluhan kapal **pencuri** ikan ditangkap.

9. **Theft** of personal data on the internet often occurs. [with ‘pribadi’]

Pencurian data pribadi di internet sering terjadi.
