

JADI - words to do with 'become, happen'

* Saya ingin **menjadi** insinyur.

*I'd like to **become** an engineer.*

* Dia sudah bertahun-tahun **menjadi** guru.

*S/he has **been** a teacher for years.*

* Kecelakaan itu **terjadi** tadi malam.

*The accident **occurred** last night.*

* **Kejadian** itu sangat menyedihkan.

*That **incident** was extremely sad.*

Notes

* **menjadi** (v): to become; to be

[“menjadi” is often used to mean: not to *become* something, but rather, simply to *be* something. For instance, if someone says in English, “It’s hard to be a good parent”, they do not mean that it’s hard to turn into such a parent, i.e., to become one. They simply mean instead that it’s hard to inhabit that role, to *be* one. And that idea can be naturally expressed in Indonesian as “Sulit *menjadi* orang tua yang baik”.]

* **terjadi** (v): to happen, to occur

* **kejadian** (n): an occurrence; an incident; an event

2. Tsunamis like that are an extremely rare **event**. [with ‘langka’]

5. That businessman/woman **became** extremely rich.
6. What **happened** between you and Rizi?
7. He **got** angry when Fitri broke up with him. [with ‘putus’]
8. Bu Ida, how long have you **been** school principal?
9. **Incidents** like that never **happen** here.
