

# JAHAT - words to do with 'wicked, crime'

\* Dia bukan orang **jahat** tetapi dia suka berbohong.

*S/he's not a **bad** person but s/he tells lies.*

\* Tugas utama polisi adalah untuk menangkap **penjahat**.

*The main task of the police is to catch **criminals**.*

\* Tingkat **kejahatan** di negara itu sangat tinggi.

*The **crime** rate in that country is extremely high.*

## Notes

\* **jahat** (adj): bad, wicked, evil

\* **penjahat** (n): a criminal

\* **kejahatan** (n): a crime, crime

**Practice.** Say it in Indonesian. For each word in bold use a JAHAT word.

1. Several of his employees are former **criminals**. [with 'mantan']

Beberapa karyawannya adalah mantan **penjahat**.

2. Tourists there can become victims of street **crime**. [with 'jalanan']

Wisatawan di sana bisa menjadi korban **kejahatan** jalanan.

3. S/he cried when s/he read the **nasty** comments. [with 'komentar']

Dia menangis ketika membaca komentar **jahat** itu.

4. No, I'm not angry – s/he didn't have **bad** intentions. [with 'niat']

Tidak, saya tidak marah -- dia tidak mempunyai niat **jahat**.

5. They don't try to catch perpetrators of small **crimes**. [with 'pelaku']

Mereka tidak berusaha menangkap para pelaku **kejahatan** kecil.

6. S/he said that sex **criminals** should be punished more heavily.

Dia mengatakan bahwa **penjahat** seks harus dihukum lebih berat.

7. S/he could not get rid of those **evil** thoughts. [with 'menghilangkan']

Dia tidak bisa menghilangkan pikiran **jahat** itu.

8. There are some very dangerous types of cyber **crime**. [with 'siber']

Ada beberapa jenis **kejahatan** siber yang sangat berbahaya.

9. Why are they being treated like **criminals**? [with 'diperlakukan']

Mengapa mereka diperlakukan seperti **penjahat**?
