

JUAL – words to do with “sell”

* Mereka akan **menjual** rumah itu tahun depan.

*They will **sell** that house next year.*

* Rumah itu akan **dijual** tahun depan.

*That house will **be sold** next year.*

* Negara itu melarang **penjualan** rokok kepada anak di bawah umur.

*That country prohibited **the selling** of cigarettes to under-age children.*

* Dia bekerja sebagai **penjual** mobil bekas.

*S/he works as a used car **seller** / salesperson.*

Notes

* **menjual** (v): to sell (something).

* **penjualan** (n): the selling of (something), the sale of (sth.).

[‘penjualan’ is the act of “menjual”]

* **penjual** (v): a seller, salesperson, vendor. [A ‘penjual’ does the action of ‘menjual’]

Practice. Say it in Indonesian. For each word in bold use a JUAL word. (Be ready to choose between *menjual* and *dijual* as needed.)

1. The **sale** of motorbikes rose thirty percent.

Penjualan motor meningkat (or ‘naik’) tigapuluh persen.

2. There are a lot of newspaper **sellers** in the streets.

(Ada) banyak **penjual** koran di jalan.

3. Batik shirts like that **are sold** everywhere.

Kemeja batik seperti itu **dijual** di mana-mana.

4. I work in a flower shop. [i.e., ‘a shop, **seller** of flowers’]

Saya bekerja di toko **penjual** bunga.

5. That company uses effective **sales** tactics / **selling** tactics. [with ‘taktik’]

Perusahaan itu menggunakan taktik **penjualan** yang efektif.

6. Why did they **sell** their business?

Mengapa mereka **menjual** bisnisnya (or 'usahanya')?

7. Formerly s/he was a vegetable **seller** at the market.

Dulu dia **penjual** sayuran di pasar.

8. Everybody can do online **selling**. [with 'online']

Semua orang bisa melakukan **penjualan** online.

9. Last year they **sold** goods worth more than 10 billion rupiah. [with 'bernilai']

Tahun lalu mereka **menjual** barang (yang) bernilai lebih dari Rp10 miliar.
