

KAYA – words to do with ‘rich’

* Orang itu sangat **kaya**.

That person is very rich.

* Those types of food are **rich** in protein.

*Jenis makanan itu **kaya** dengan protein.*

* Kata-kata asing seperti itu **memperkaya** bahasa Indonesia.

*Foreign words like that **enrich** Indonesian.*

* Bahasa Indonesia **diperkaya** dengan kata asing seperti itu.

*Indonesian **is enriched** by foreign words like that.*

* Dia terkenal karena kecantikan dan **kekayaannya**.

*She is famous for her beauty and **wealth**.*

* Sumber daya alam merupakan bagian dari **kekayaan** negara.

*Natural resources are part of the national **wealth** / the nation’s **assets**.*

Notes

* **kaya** (adj): rich

* **memperkaya** (v): to enrich (something); to make (sth.) richer

* **kekayaan** (n): wealth, assets, property.

Practice. Say it in Indonesian. For each word in bold, use a KAYA word. (Be ready to choose between *memperkaya* and *diperkaya* as needed.)

1. S/he wants to be **rich** and successful.
2. Experiences like that **enrich** one’s life.
3. They admire the **richness** of Indonesian culture.
4. That drink **is enriched** with vitamin D.
5. A lot of people become arrogant because of their **wealth**.
6. S/he is one of the **richest** people in Singapore.
7. They want to live in Italy to **enrich** their knowledge about Europe. [with ‘pengetahuan’]
8. He used his **wealth** to build a new library. (with ‘menggunakan’]
9. Jerusalem is a city that is **rich** in history. [with ‘Yerusalem’]
