

## UBAH - words to do with 'change'

\* Dia telah sangat **berubah**.

*She has greatly **changed**.*

\* Pemerintah harus **mengubah** sistem pajak.

*The government should **change** the tax system.*

\* Sistem pajak harus **diubah** oleh pemerintah.

*The tax system should **be changed** by the government.*

\* India mengalami **perubahan** besar.

*India is experiencing large **changes**.*

### Notes

\* **berubah** (v): to change, i.e., to become different

\* **mengubah** (v): to change (something), i.e., to make it become different

\* **perubahan** (n): a change

**Practice.** Say it in Indonesian. For each word in bold use an UBAH word. (Be ready to choose between *mengubah* and *diubah* as needed.)
